POSITIVE IMPACT PORT DE BARCELONA (PI)

Positive Impact (PI) is a project that was born in 2015 under the name of Sectorial Sustainability Plan (PSS) with the aim of getting to know how the Port Community as a whole, responds to the expectations of stakeholders while becoming the Port Community's Sectoral Sustainability Observatory, through an uninterrupted annual survey 2015–2022.

It is a unique initiative carried out by the port community at an international level. Currently **116 organizations** have committed to the project.

From 2022 onwards, Positive Impact Port will continue to act as a Sustainability Observatory, but at the same time it takes a step forward, to lead progress

in sustainability and to make the Port Community of Barcelona pioneer in sustainability, leadership and commitment.



COMMITTEDORGANIZATIONS

The **116 member organizations**, including Port Authority of Barcelona, have participated in the data collection, carried out during the months of February and March 2023, sharing data of year 2022. The information found here is aggregated data from the results of the 2022 annual survey.

These organizations bring together more than **8,582 employees** and represent almost 23% of the total number of organizations in the Port Community.

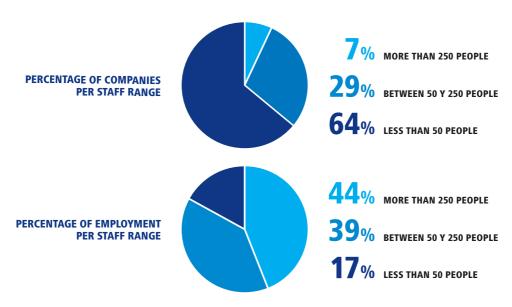
